Second Amendment rights. The right to self-defense is one of man's most basic natural rights. The Second Amendment to the United States Constitution codifies that the natural right of citizens to keep and bear arms "shall not be infringed." Twenty Five states currently allow law-abiding citizens to carry concealed weapons without a permit; these are called "Constitutional Carry" states. These states allow citizens to protect themselves and their families from criminals by not restricting the citizens' right to self-defense.
